What is SRTLTC?

SRTLTC stands for the Southern Region Teen Leadership Conference. This first-of-its-kind regional 4-H conference was created to develop leadership, citizenship, team-building, communication and other life skills in youth while embracing diversity, strengthening connections throughout the Southern region and motivating participants to become involved by creating and implementing action plans. The 2008 conference is expected to be even better with more participants, new workshops, and a strong emphasis on Youth Adult Partnerships!

Who can attend?

Any Southern Region 4-Her ages 14-18

When and where is it?

The 2008 SRTLTC will take place September 4th- 7th at the Clyde York 4-H Center in Crossville, Tennessee.

How much does it cost?

The registration fee for the conference is \$165 for youth and adults. This includes lodging, meals and a t-shirt. States may need to charge additional fees based on costs for their delegation.

What will I do?

The four-day program will feature several youth-and adult-led workshops and "funshops," which teach useful team-building and leadership skills; as well as youth-adult workgroup meetings, which will guide groups to develop their action plans. Evening activities will consist of dances, movies, campfires, fun games and other activities.
