AIR RIFLE - JUNIOR, INTERMEDIATE, AND SENIOR

Equipment:

- When not in use, CBIs (Clear Barrel Indicators) are required. Firearms must be carried in a case on property. Firearms will be inspected.
- No sharing of air rifles. Each shooter **MUST** have his/her own equipment.
- Footwear is restricted to soft, low-cut athletic or street shoes that do not extend above the ankle. **No BOOTS are permitted.** Shooting gloves are permitted but **shooting jackets are NOT permitted.** Slings are permitted.
- **.177 caliber air rifles 7.5 lbs. or less; metallic sights; safe trigger pull upon inspection - no precision class rifles**

Metallic 1/10 Scale Silhouettes

Directions:

1. Youth shoot in banks of five targets, from left to right.
 2. Intermediates and Seniors: There is a 15 second ready time and 2.5 minutes of firing time per bank of targets. No time limit for Juniors.
 3. Standing position is without support.
 4. Targets must be knocked over or from its stand in order to be scored as a hit.
- **Intermediates and Seniors: 10 chickens at 20 yards 5 chickens at Juniors: 10 yards**
 - **Intermediates and Seniors: 10 pigs at 30 yards 5 pigs at Juniors: 20 yards**
 - **Intermediates and Seniors: 10 turkeys at 36 yards 5 turkeys at Juniors: 26 yards**
 - **Intermediates and Seniors: 10 rams at 45 yards 5 rams at Juniors: 35 yards**

NRA 10 Meter Air Rifle Paper Targets (NRA AR-5/10) and NRA 5 Meter BB Gun Paper Targets (NRA AR-4/5) (Juniors)

Directions:

1. Intermediate and Senior youth shoot 20 shots in each position; Juniors shoot 10 shots per position.
 2. There are three positions: standing, prone and kneeling.
 3. Intermediates and Seniors: Youth have 1.5 minutes per shot for kneeling and prone and 2 minutes per shot for standing. Juniors: Youth have 10 minutes preparation; 20 minutes each for prone and kneeling positions and 25 minutes for the standing position.
- **Intermediates and Seniors: 60 shots at 10 meters Juniors: 30 shots at 5 meters**

NRA 10 Meter Air Rifle Paper Targets (NRA AR-5/10)

Directions:

1. Intermediate and Senior youth shoot 40 shots standing.
 2. Youth have 2 minutes per shot for standing.
- **Intermediates and Seniors: 40 shots at 10 meters**

SMALLBORE RIFLE - INTERMEDIATE AND SENIOR (NO JUNIORS)

Equipment:

- When not in use, CBIs (Clear Barrel Indicators) are required. Firearms must be carried in a case on property. Firearms will be inspected.
- No sharing of rifles. Each shooter MUST have his/her own equipment.
- Footwear is restricted to soft, low-cut athletic or street shoes that do not extend above the ankle. No BOOTS are permitted. Shooting gloves are permitted but shooting jackets are NOT permitted. Slings are permitted.
- .22 caliber smallbore rifles 10 lbs. 2 oz. lbs. or less; telescopic and/or metallic sights; safe trigger pull upon inspection; up to .22 rimfire long

Metallic 1/5 Scale Silhouettes

Directions:

1. Youth shoot in banks of five targets, from left to right.
2. Intermediates and Seniors: There is a 15 second ready time and 2.5 minutes of firing time per bank of targets. Standing position is without support.
3. Targets must be knocked over or from its stand in order to be scored as a hit.
 - **10 chickens at 40 yards**
 - **10 pigs at 60 yards**
 - **10 turkeys at 77 yards**
 - **10 rams at 100 yards**

NRA 50 Yard UIT Smallbore Rifle Paper Targets (NRA AR-51) - Three Position

Directions:

1. Intermediate and Senior youth shoot 20 shots in each position. Metallic sights only, any safe .22 cartridge.
2. There are three positions: standing, prone and kneeling.
3. Intermediates and Seniors: Youth have 1.5 minutes per shot for kneeling, 1 minute per shot prone and 2 minutes per shot for standing.
 - **Intermediates and Seniors: 60 shots at 50 yards**

SMALLBORE RIFLE - INTERMEDIATE AND SENIOR

- In Timed Fire and Rapid Fire stages: after the "Load" command, all actions must be locked open prior to the "start" command. Manually holding the action open is not permitted. Actions may not be unlocked or closed until the shooter is in the firing position with firearm safely pointed down range.
- Overall weight of rifle may not exceed 7.5 lbs., with sights; trigger pull of at least 3 lbs.
- Sporter rifle barrels only; open sights, receiver sights or scope not exceeding 6x magnification; fixed slings no wider than 1.25"; standard sporter stock

NRA 25/50 Yard Pistol Paper Targets (B-19) - CMP Rimfire Sporter

Directions:

1. Slow fire - 10 shots in 10 minutes; Rapid fire - 5 shots in 25 seconds (semi-auto) or 30 seconds for manual repeater

50 yards:

- Prone - 10 shots each for slow fire and rapid fire
- Sitting or Kneeling - 10 shots each for slow fire and rapid fire

25 yards:

- Standing - 10 shots each for slow fire and rapid fire

OTHER RULES - for SMALLBORE RIFLE AND AIR RIFLE

- Coaches and parents do not coach after the match begins.
- Competitors may NOT speak to officials once the match begins UNLESS there is a SAFETY or MECHANICAL issue.
- Officials may NOT speak to competitors once the match begins UNLESS there is a SAFETY or MECHANICAL issue.
- Refer to the National 4-H Shooting Sports Rules and Florida 4-H Shooting Sports Rules.
- Only competitors may bring an inquiry. A \$5 fee will be required.
