

Orientation for Room Monitors

Thank you for your commitment to the 4-H program and the 4-H'ers competing today. There are a few things to remember as a room monitor.

BEFORE DEMONSTRATIONS BEGIN:

1. Introduce yourself.
2. Introduce the judges to the people in the room.

FOR EACH DEMONSTRATION:

1. Help 4-H'ers set up demonstrations. Make sure they have everything arranged the way they need it.
2. Ask judges if they are ready to begin.
3. If so, let 4-H'ers know they may begin.
4. Keep track of length of demonstrations for judges.
5. If necessary, remind audience that judges are the **ONLY** individuals who may ask questions of competing 4-H'ers.

OTHER THINGS TO REMEMBER:

1. Keep demonstrations running on a smooth schedule and according to the order in the program.
2. Keep order in the room during demonstrations. Do not allow traffic in and out of the room during demonstrations.
3. If any problems arise, please bring your questions to the judge's room.
