

# FIELD ARCHERY

Outdoor field archers shoot on a walking course (kind of like a golf course, but with lots of trees). Target distances vary from less than 10 yards to 50 yards depending on the archer's age. Archers shoot in small groups of 3-4, and each archer shoots four arrows at each target. Five is the highest possible score for each arrow. So an archer can score 20 points for each target, and 280 points for the total of 14 targets. If you miss the target and you are not able to find your arrow within 2 minutes, write down what target number it is, and where you think the arrow may be so you can go back and look for it after the tournament. This tournament will take roughly three hours, so snacks and water are very important.

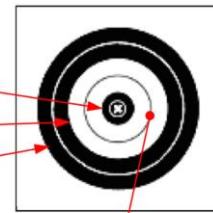
## FIELD ROUND

**STANDARD UNIT**  
14 targets form a Unit. Twice around a Unit makes a Round. (Qualifier)

### TARGET FACE

#### SCORING

5 points  
4 points  
3 points



*An arrow shaft need only touch the line to be counted in the area of next higher value.*

#### SHOOTING RULES

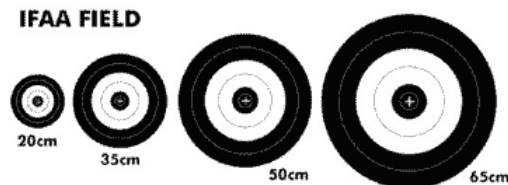
Each archer shall shoot (4) arrows at each of the 14 target layouts in a unit.

## 4H Conversions:

“Youth” = 4H Senior, max 50 yards (14-18 years old as of September 1, 2019)  
 “Cub” = 4H Intermediate, max 30 yards (11-13 years old as of September 1, 2019)  
 “Pee Wee” = 4H Junior, max 15 yards (8-10 years old as of September 1, 2019)
