THINGS TO PAY ATTENTION TO



DRESS CODE

Knowing what to wear is always a challenge. To help, below are guidelines to follow for the activities you will be attending.

The following clothing will not be permitted under any circumstances:

- Halter tops and muscle shirts **MAY NOT** be worn.
- Spaghetti strap shirt may not be worn.
- Sleeveless shirts should have straps that are at least 2 inches wide.
- No see-through garments.
- Clothing with obscene or offensive language or messages pertaining to alcohol, cigarettes and violence will not be permitted.
- No pajamas are to be worn outside of the cabin.
- No undergarments or foundation garments should be showing.
- Shoes must be worn at all times.

All clothing must meet the following guidelines:

- Pants and shorts **MUST** be worn at the waistline.
- Caps and western hats **MAY NOT** be worn at meal times.
- Nametags must be worn in the proper position at all times
- All dresses, shorts and skirts must be at pinky finger length.

Attire for the weekend will be **CASUAL!**

LUGGAGE

Pack lightly. If you can not carry it yourself, don't bring it! Make sure you can get all of your gear to your cabin! Comfortable shoes should be included in your luggage. We recommend you bring a pair of tennis shoes for outdoor activities.

PACKING

Along with all the "regular" things you would bring with you on a trip, you are also responsible for bringing linens – pillow, blanket, sleeping bag, sheets, towels etc. You will also want to bring an alarm clock, toiletries and a notebook and pen for writing down important things you need to take back to your district and county!

Remember, we are **NOT** responsible for any items that may be lost or stolen. You can help prevent this problem by leaving items such as portable CD players, I-pods, and cell phones at home or locked in your car. Cell phones should be used responsibly and courteously at all times (they should not be used during meetings for talking or text messaging and should be turned off or put on silent). Lastly, weapons, illegal drugs and alcoholic beverages are **STRICTLY PROHIBITED!!**

MONEY

You may want to bring money to purchase items at the State Council Store. These items may include snacks, soda, shirts, hats etc. There is also usually some kind of fundraiser going on that weekend to raise money for the Executive Board. You may be responsible for some meals on your travels to and from the camp. Meals during the weekend that will be provided include Saturday Breakfast thru Sunday Breakfast. **THERE IS NO DINNER SERVED ON FRIDAY.**
